- No credit is awarded for the following CLEP examinations: **College Composition MODULAR, Financial Accounting, French Language, German Language, Introductory Business Law, Principles of Management, Principles of Marketing, and Spanish Language.**
- No Credit is awarded for the **DANTES DSST** examinations.
- Credit will not be awarded for CLEP scores on the basis of their appearance on the transcript of another institution.
- No more than 32 hours of CLEP credit or a combination of AP, IB, CLEP, and department-based credit by examination may be used toward a WSU degree, except by petition. All credit will be recorded on the student record.
- All scale scores for the General Examinations in English Composition, Humanities, Mathematics, Natural Science, and Social Science will be reported as a two-digit number. The score scale for the general exams has switched from 200-800 to 20-80. In addition, the General Examinations are now Subject Examinations based on the College Board's July 2001 revisions.
